

SIMPLE KNIT SHRUG PATTERN

made by marni







Skills required

Knit and purl stitches Increase & decrease Optional single crochet border

Yarn

4-6 skeins of Lion Brand Vanna's Choice (or a worsted weight yarn). Knit with double strands throughout.

Needles

US 13 (9mm) knitting needles Size J crochet hook (optional border)

Gauge

8 stitches = 4" (10 cm) 12 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Measurements - Size S (M, L)

Sleeve to sleeve length: 54" (57", 60") Widest part (back): 18" (19", 20")

Abbreviations

K knit P purl st(s) stitch(es) k2tog knit next 2 sts together [1 st decreased] ssk slip 2 sts knitwise, then knit them together [1 st decreased]

Sleeve 1 (60 rows)

Cast on 20 (22, 24) sts

Row 1: (WS) purl

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6 (Increase Row): Knit in the front and back of the first and last stitch of this row = 22

(24, 26) sts.

Repeat these 6 rows 8 (9, 10) times

Knit 6 more rows *without* increasing and place a marker for sleeve 1 end.

Back 54 (57, 60) rows

(WS) Continue in for 54 (57, 60) rows. Place marker for sleeve 2 beginning.

Sleeve 2 (60 rows)

Row 1: (WS) purl

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6 (Decrease Row): k2tog, knit to last 2 stitches,

ssk.

Repeat this 8 (9, 10) times.


Knit 6 more rows without decreasing and cast off.

Finishing:

Pin to measurements and block. Sew sleeve seams from place markers to the ends. Weave in any ends.

Optional Border:

With J crochet hook and double strands of yarn, pick up and single crochet all of the back piece stitches. Approx 100 (106, 112) SC around once more and bind off. Weave in ends.



Sleeve to sleeve length: 54" (57", 60") | Widest part (back): 18" (19", 20")

SLEEVE 1: Get your stitch counter out and use this table to keep track of your increases:

BACK: Start stitch marker at zero and do 54 (57, 60) rows for the back piece. End on Knit row. Place markers on each end to mark the opening.

SLEEVE 2: Set stitch marker back to zero and keep track of your decreases:
